Software Enhancements Help Retailers Implement Self-Checkout Faster and Lower Management Costs

The core of the new release is an improved integration framework that uses Extensible Markup Language (XML) technology to facilitate the connection between the self-checkout solution and the retailer's existing point-of-sale (POS) system. This new framework provides significant time and cost savings for retailers as most changes made to their existing POS systems, such as the addition of new payment types including gift cards, will now automatically be reflected within the self-checkout system.

Another new feature, the NCR YourPOS(TM) Assist Mode, allows attendants to complete complex transactions on the self-checkouts, such as tax-exempt sales, which were previously only available on the retailer's traditional POS software. In addition to enhancing customer service, this capability makes it easier for retailers to cross-train operators for self-checkout attendant and traditional cashier positions.
